## 1. Significance to Pakistan Studies

Pakistan is as much under threat of climate change impacts as Bangladesh, the focus of the book that I was presenting on at the Lahore Thinkfest 2024, titled *In Quest of a Shared Planet: Negotiating Climate from the Global South*. I engaged in discussion with Adil Najam, the premier climate scientist of Pakistan on the concerns and investments of our respective countries within the UN sponsored climate negotiation process. ## 2. Key Outcomes and Deliverables

I am working on an op-ed I hope to complete shortly on my participation in the Thinkfest and the productivity of that space for approaching difficult questions with a broad audience, particularly young people.
